Technical Regulations

This competition will be held in accordance with the Scottish Cycling and British Cycling [Technical Regulations](#). All competitors should familiarise themselves with the current Scottish Cycling National Track Championship Technical Regulations.

Scottish Championship Eligibility

To be eligible for a Scottish Championship title, riders must meet at least one of the following criteria:

SC2.2.1 Persons whose primary club is affiliated to Scottish Cycling (licence showing that club or team at the time entries close).

SC2.2.2 Scottish Nationals (persons born in Scotland).

SC2.2.3 Scottish Residents (persons who have continuously lived in Scotland for the last three consecutive years prior to the day of the Championship).

SC2.2.4 Persons who have at least one parent who was born in Scotland.

SC2.2.5 Members of the armed forces who meet none of the above, but who by necessity are required to live in Scotland away from their normal residence.

SC2.3 For team Championships, excluding Track, each team member must be eligible under SC2.2 and have the same Primary Club or Team showing on their licence at the time of entries closing. Clubs or Teams must be affiliated to any UCI recognised governing body.

Venue

This championship takes place at the Sir Chris Hoy Velodrome which is located inside the Emirates Arena, a Glasgow Club facility. As a result of this, access to the building for the championships, will be the same as the buildings access times which are as follows:

Friday: Access from 16:00

Saturday: Access from 08:00

Sunday: Access from 08:00

Sign On

Riders should enter the Emirates Arena through the main entrance and follow signs to the track centre.

The sign-on desk will be located in the track centre, to the right at the top of the stairs. There is a ramp to the left of the stairs, past the bike cages, which also takes you to the rider pen area. Each rider will be issued with a pack including:

- Rider numbers
- Timing chip
- Rider wristband
- Helper wristband

Please have your race licence ready for inspection at sign on. Licences must be valid, signed, with appropriate photograph and will be held by the event organiser for the duration of the event. Licences will be returned in exchange for rider numbers and timing chips at the completion of competition.

Each Rider will be issued with one helper wristband which must be worn by their designated helper to access track centre. Additional helper wristbands can be purchased at a cost of £3 from the sign on desk. Any spectators or those without rider/support staff wristbands will not be permitted to remain in Track Centre.

Race Numbers

Two body numbers will be issued at sign on. Numbers must be positioned as shown by the image below. Both numbers must be clearly visible and not obscured if using pockets. For pursuits, team sprints and time trials, one number may be worn.

Any competitor who loses a number(s) should contact the sign on desk for a replacement prior to their event – lost numbers will be subject to £20 fine.



Clothing and Equipment

Riders must wear the kit of their registered 2023 club or team. Any riders who are not members of a club or team must wear plain coloured kit. For the Team Pursuit and Team Sprint, all team riders must wear matching kit.

It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their bike is in safe working order and meets competition regulations. The commissaire team may carry out visual inspections of any competitor's bike prior to the start of any event and 'spot' checks throughout the event.

You are reminded that you are responsible for your own equipment during the event. Scottish Cycling, the Emirates Arena or any event partners will not accept responsibility for loss or damage.

Keirin, Sprint and Team events

Riders for the above events should bring their own holders.

Warm Up

There will be on track warm up available at the start of each day of racing as per the event running order. During the first half hour, no standing starts will be permitted. During the second half hour, only standing starts will be permitted below blue line. Use of the track outside of these times is not permitted. All competitors must access the track via the home straight and exit on the back straight.

Riders must have their race numbers showing clearly to access the track warm up.

The commissaire team will monitor the number of riders on track at any one time and may ask you to wait if the track is at capacity. Please ride responsibly and look out for all other competitors. Dangerous riding will be penalised.

Rider helpers

Riders will be permitted to bring one helper into track centre only who will be issued with a wristband at the sign-on desk. Additional helpers wristbands may be purchased at the cost of £3 per day.

Helper passes and rider wristbands will also enable access to the stands, unless they are close to capacity. Only a small section of the stands will be open for the duration of the event.

Spectators

Tickets for the stands can be purchased [here](#) at a nominal cost of £3 per day. Please show the stewards confirmation of your purchase at the entrance. The stands can be accessed via the stairs outside the building, or there is accessible access via the lifts in the centre of the building.

Rider pens

Rider pens must be kept in a clean and tidy condition. Be considerate of your fellow competitors and their equipment. Rubbish must be placed in the bins provided. Riders are asked to not change in track centre and use the dedicated changing rooms.

Podium Presentations

Riders that have secured a podium position will be required to attend the victory ceremony of the competition. The running order of victory ceremonies is published within the event schedule.

Riders must report to the podium area five minutes before the victory ceremony in their Club/Team jersey as listed on the start sheet. No helmets, protective eye wear, head bands, caps etc. may be worn for the ceremony. Riders should wear appropriate footwear or cycling shoes – NOT sliders, crocs or similar.

Media

Scottish Cycling will be filming at the event, as well as having dedicated photographers present throughout the weekend. If you would prefer not to appear in any event publications, please make this known in advance by email and let the sign on team know.

Any additional photographers wishing to capture the event must register their details in advance and be briefed by the commissaire team on the day.

The venue is directly across the road from Celtic Park and is signposted as the Emirates Arena.

By Road

At junction 2A on the M74, take the A74 exit to Tollcross /Cambuslang. At the roundabout, take the exit onto Fullarton Rd /London Rd/A74. After Celtic Park, turn left onto Clyde Gateway (A728) and turn left again at the traffic lights to enter the venue car park. There are 2 car parks accessible via the first and second exits of the roundabout.

By Bike

The Arena is only a 10 minute cycle from Glasgow City Centre and both Glasgow Central and Glasgow Queen Street train stations. Where there are over 200 cycling spaces available.

By Public Transport

By Bus

The nearest bus stops to the Emirates Arena are at The Forge Retail Park, just a short walk away. Shuttle buses run from Glasgow City Centre for some events taking place at the Emirates.

By Train

Train services at Dalmarnock Rail Station are on a 4 per hour basis all day on Monday to Saturday on the Argyle Line through Glasgow Central Low Level. Check train service times to Dalmarnock [here](#).
