Responsibilities:

- Support in identifying a team of riders where required
- Attend team selection/training days/races (as appropriate)
- Support the team manager in carrying out their duties pre event and during the event itself
- Provide coaching advice and feedback to the riders
- Create a positive learning and development experience for riders
- Uphold duty of care throughout the event ensuring relevant levels of supervision are achieved
- To read and abide by the event manual, safeguarding plan and role specific code of conduct (where provided)
- Ensure that behaviour is in line with the coaching guidelines and code of practice
- Travel with the team as and when required and contribute to the driving to, during and from the event.

Person Specification:

- Be a current British Cycling member
- Be a member of the PVG Scheme with Scottish Cycling
- Have up to date safeguarding training
- Hold a current valid British Cycling verified first aid certificate
- Hold a British Cycling Level 2 Coaching qualification or equivalent
- Has good knowledge of the best practices when working with young people
- Has good knowledge and understanding of rules relate to youth racing and able to communicate them
- Has experience of coaching youth bike riders in a competition setting
- Organised and approachable
