

2026 Scottish Cycling Alba Series Series Regulations

General

All events will be delivered in line with the British Cycling Technical Regulations, classified as National B races, open to Elite, 1st, 2nd and 3rd category riders.

Event Registration and Entry System

All events will be registered online with British Cycling and will use the British Cycling Event Management System. Organisers should ensure that they link their event to the series ‘Scottish Cycling Alba Road Race Series’ when registering their event.

Presentations

A podium ceremony will be held for the top three finishing riders at the end of each round. The Event Organisers will be responsible for the provision of suitable prizes for each round.

Scottish Cycling will provide winners jerseys for the Series which will be presented where possible at the end of the last round.

Finish Line Resources

The Event Organiser should ensure a judging team is in place at the finish line. There will be an area for finish line resources by the start/finish line of each race. This area will be cordoned off and will not be accessible to riders or spectators.

Electronic timing equipment is available from Scottish Cycling, but is not mandatory for producing results. The use of finish line video recording is recommended in the absence of electronic timing. Every effort should be made to produce a full result including all riders who start the race.

Commissaires

Scottish Cycling will appoint the commissaire panel for each event, and will cover their expenses. The Event Organiser will receive notification of this following the Scottish Cycling Commissaire Appointment Process.

Series Points

Series points will be awarded to riders after each race. Points will be awarded according to the points table below. All rounds will count towards the final rankings.

In the event of a points tie in the series standings, the result shall be decided based upon finish position in the most recent event.

Club Competition

A rider must represent their first claim club, as printed on their British Cycling race licence. The finish positions from the top three riders from each club will count towards the club series ranking.

For the club series competition, all rounds of the series will count. A club will be listed in the overall club series competition when they have greater than two riders at any one round of the series.

The club series standings will be compiled following each event, using the series points from the top three riders from each club combined to create an overall club series winner.
